

21st CCLC After School FAQ

1) How much is this program for my student to attend?

- This program is **free** for all students attending Provident Charter School since we are the recipient of the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program grant.

2) When does the After-School Program start?

- Tuesday, September 5th 3:30pm - 6:30pm
- After-School occurs only Monday - Thursday
- We will always follow the school calendar (some off days are different)
- The After School Program is only 36 weeks
- Last Day will be Thursday, May 30th, 2024

3) Are learning opportunities available at the After-School Program?

- Daily math and reading interventions (45 minutes each)
- Daily programming (30 minutes each)
- Dinner will also be provided for students
- Additional programs occurring this fall season include Tae Kwon Do, Attack Theatre, STEAM Activities, Art, Family Links, Improv and Cub scouts

4) How do I register my child for the After-School Program?

- All families must meet with program director prior to the first day their student attends after school

5) Does my child have to attend every day?

- Your child does not have to commit to all four days in order to attend the After-School Program. We do ask that families please commit to a consistent schedule every week (i.e. attending Mondays & Wednesdays only) and that they commit to the duration of the program. However, emergencies do come up, and we're very understanding of changes. Thank you for communicating in advance.
