Our Health Office at Provident manages many medically complex students. We are looking for a PRN LPN to join our school nurse on a PRN basis, but with the potential to add more hours in the future. On these days the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) responsibilities include:

- Follow a designated care plan in accordance with patients' needs
- Perform assigned duties, including administration of medication, wound care, treatments, and procedures
- Monitor clients' conditions; reporting changes to our RN
- Follow up with, execute, and properly document doctor's orders
- Accurately document observations, interventions, and evaluations pertaining to client care management and services provided

Requirements include:

- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) active license in the State of Pennsylvania (PA)
- Current CPR Certification (We can offer a class)

- One (1) year of experience in healthcare; home care, home health, hospital, and/or long-term care environment preferred
