

FAQS FOR PCS AFTER SCHOOL

- **How much is this program for my student to attend?**
 - This program is free for all students attending Provident charter school since we are the recipient of the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program grant.
- **When does the after school program start?**
 - Tuesday, September 8th 3:30pm - 6:30pm
 - After school is only Monday- Thursday
 - Last day of after school is June 8th
 - We will always follow the school calendar
- **What goes on during after school ?**
 - Daily Math and reading interventions (45 minutes each)
 - Daily programing (30 minutes each)
 - Dinner will also be provided for students
 - Programs this fall will be TaeKwonDo, Attack theatre, Steam activities with Children's museum, girls with confidence group, Boys with confidence, Improv, attack theatre, Dance and basketball.
- **How do I register my student for the after school program?**

- **Does my Student have to attend everyday?**
 - You do not have to commit to all four days. If you only want to attend 1, 2, or 3 days that is permitted. We do ask that the days be consistent.
 - It is highly recommended that your student stay the entire program. But, emergencies do come up and we're very understanding
