Possible Updates to Health and Safety Plan

 We are considering eliminating the Daily Opt-In as an option, but keeping the Extended Remote option.

(reasons include: inconsistency for students, affects the remote learning group dynamic, periodically results in changes for remote and proximate groups, attendance does not equal learning, and transportation complications)

 This could occur as early as end of Trimester 1, Nov 30th, or after winter break (Jan. 19th)



Other Considerations

- We are considering a 2 week required remote learning for ALL students and staff after our December holiday break.
- This would result in a return to proximate (in person)
 learning or extended remote learning on January 19, 2021.
- PCS Board meeting next Tuesday, Nov. 10th, and next Town Hall Wed., Nov. 11th.
