I hope everyone had a restful and healthy break! As the vibrant colors of spring begin to bloom around us, it's a timely reminder of the growth our students have experienced this school year. Have you noticed your child's growth since the first day of school? I know I have and I predict that during these last few weeks they will shine even brighter. I want to continue to emphasize the significance of attending school and fully engaging in the learning experiences happening each day. Provident truly values partnership with parents and caregivers.



Attendance Incentives:

Our attendance incentive will continue to run through the months of April and May and finish on Friday, May 24, 2024. Students can earn the incentive by achieving a 95% attendance rate and no "Hands On" Office Discipline Referrals. The attendance rate includes all excused and unexcused absences. Families who have already submitted an educational field trip form or will do so in the future and have it approved by the principal, it will NOT count against students' absences. Additionally, any religious holiday that falls on a school day, and a note provided, will NOT count against students' absences. Take your Child to Work day on April 25th will also NOT count against the incentive. Students will earn a trip to Elevate Trampoline Park on Thursday, May 30th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Further information will be provided about the trip as we move forward into May.

PSSA Testing:

In April students will be taking the PSSA's (April 22nd-30th). Because we are a public charter school, the state requires that our students participate in the PSSA's. To ensure that students have the best testing environment possible, we ask that students attend school on the testing dates, so as not to have to make-up the test at a later date. We also ask that students get plenty of sleep and eat breakfast.

Cafeteria News:










April 23rd - Understanding the Basics of Supplemental Security Income and Social Security Disability Insurance - Free Virtual Webinar
