# About our school

Provident Charter School in Pittsburgh, PA, is a publicly funded school designed to address the needs of students with language-based learning differences such as dyslexia. Our students are bright yet struggle with topics such as reading, writing, and sequencing. Provident opened at the start of the 2016-2017 school year and has students in Grades 2-8. Located on the city's North Shore, the school enrolls about 330 students from over 44 districts in the Pittsburgh area.

# About this position

PCS Central is currently seeking a speech-language pathologist to provide individual and group therapy sessions to students who qualify for school-based speech services.

# **General Responsibilities**

- Provide school-based speech and language services to students in Grades 2-8.
- Evaluate students to determine eligibility for school-based speech and language services.
- Develop IEPs for students whose only disability category is speech and language impairment.
- Maintain compliant special education paperwork.
- Support classrooms or groups of students as needed.
- Develop strong, trusting relationships with students, parents, and staff.
- Participate in all required professional development.
- Collaborate with team members, including other speech and language pathologists, occupational therapists, school psychologists, physical therapists, teachers, etc.
- Log sessions for Medical Access.
- Administrators may assign additional responsibilities.

- 1. PA Speech and Language Certificate
- 2. Excellent communication, leadership, organization, and problem-solving skills.
- 3. Outstanding dependability, initiative, creativity, and decision-making skills
- 4. Ability to secure all relevant and necessary clearances
